DEADLINES FAST APPROACHING FOR 2019-2020 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- ✓ Any families living in Passaic, Sussex or Morris Counties that want to apply for the 2018-2019 Tri-County Scholarship must complete the online application at <https://online.factsmgmt.com/signin/3K3Q7>. Tri-County Scholarships are only available for students in grades K through 8. **The deadline for filing is February 15, 2019.** Please be aware that if you are currently receiving Tri-County funds, you **must reapply** for the 2019-2020 school year.
- ✓ In addition, you may apply for the Diocese of Paterson Catholic School Education Trust (EdTrust). The EdTrust is now open to all of our families regardless of where they reside.
